

LIST OF ACCEPTABLE HUMANITIES/SOCIAL SCIENCE REQUIREMENTS EFFECTIVE SPRING TERM 2018 (Last Revised Sept 2017)

NOTE: This list is based on the New Brunswick Undergraduate Catalog, 2009-2011, and supersedes all previous lists. Any new courses added after publication of the 2009-2011 Catalog are subject to review. Questions or appeals regarding course acceptability should be directed to a dean in the Office of Academic Services.

Rationale for H/SS Electives in the Curriculum: A good undergraduate education should provide more than the development of technical skills. Properly chosen, H/SS electives can complement your technical courses by helping you to develop an understanding of the problems facing our society, a historical consciousness, a sense of values, knowledge of other cultures, an appreciation of the fine arts, and an ability to communicate effectively. Think seriously about your choices, and use them to enhance your educational experience. Foreign language courses are allowed to be used to satisfy this requirement, with the exception of introductory courses in the student's native tongue. Engineering students are encouraged to complete a **minor** or even a **second major** in these disciplines; see <http://soe.rutgers.edu/oas/minors-majors> for more details.

School Requirements: All candidates for the B.S. degree must complete a minimum of **18 credits** of humanities/social science coursework. If a course on this list bears less than 3cr, multiple courses may be combined to total the credit requirement. H/SS courses and requirements include the following:

- Four free electives chosen from the list below;
- Free electives must be selected in a manner such that at least **two courses are at the 200/300/400 level**;
- 6cr (2 courses) out of the 18cr must be from the same subject, including at least 3cr (or 1 course) 200+ level course.
